

CORBY CHOIR ALIGHT WITH SONG

Corby Male Voice Choir is once again in fine voice and ready to embark on its 2019 concert programme as it puts the final preparations in place for its first concert of the year at the popular Celestial Candles event at the church of St Medard and St Gildard in Little Bytham on Friday 22nd March 2019 at 7.30pm.

Organised by Gordon Baldwin, the concert will raise much needed funds for the repair of the church wall and is the first of many charitable concerts Corby Male Voice Choir is set to perform in throughout the year.

Under the expert baton of its Director of Music, Mrs Jan Williams, the choir has been hard at work learning new repertoire in preparation for its busy concert schedule, in what it hopes will be another record breaking fund raising year.

Jan said, "The choir has been working really hard since January on a wide range of exciting repertoire, including some firm favourites, offering a varied programme of music which will really offer something for everyone. It is now looking forward to performing at its first concert of the year and to being part of such a special event".

She went on to say, "Since the Corby Male Voice Choir was first founded in 1976, it has helped local charitable organisations raise in excess of £300,000 for their good causes, singing at some 573 concerts. Last year the choir helped raise almost £8,000 for good causes and local charities and with nine concerts already confirmed, hope that 2019 will be another record breaking year".
